It's done! It's finished! The Bangor Library has a NEW ROOF!

Have you seen it? It's beautiful. The copper trim shines in the sun—the dark slate adds elegance to South Main Street. The new (and open) copper downspouts guide rainwater away from the building. So far, NO LEAKS, no buckets to collect water inside. New slate, completely new decking, new gutters, new downspouts—be sure and see it. Drive by, especially on a sunny day. Or better yet, stand on the sidewalk before you come into the Library—see how bright and shiny the new roof looks.

BUT, IT'S NOT PAID FOR YET.

The Library needs to raise *the rest of the money*. We're not done yet. The roof fund is \$34,000 short—check the \$\$\$\$ thermometer in the Library's front window.

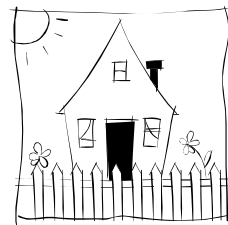
Audio Books Are Here...

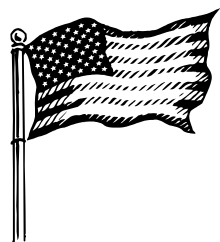
