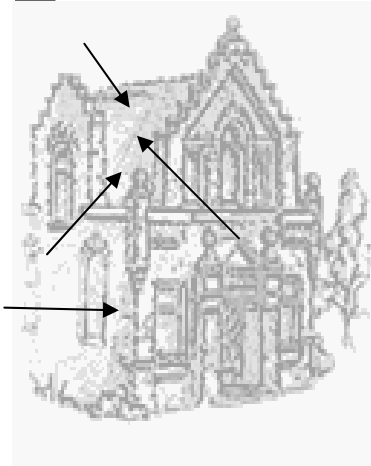

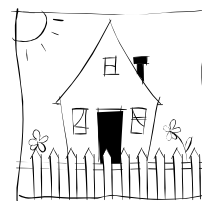
The Library Friends will meet May 22, 7:30 P.M., upstairs, at the library. Meetings and membership are open to all adult residents of the Bangor Area School District.

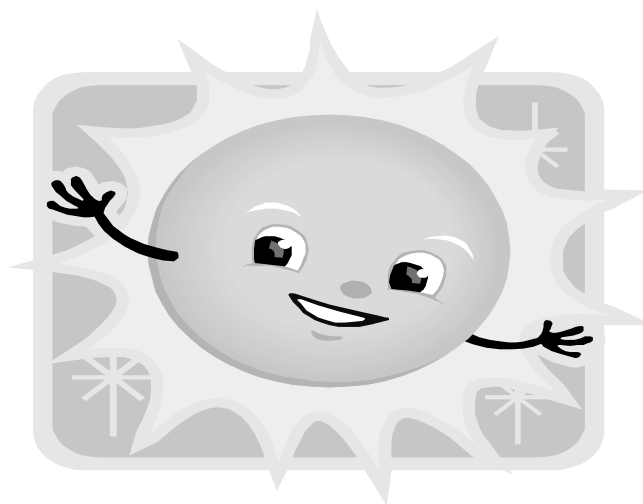
