Several local officials came to the library for the occasion: Anthony Biondi, Merchants Bank; Sen. Lisa Boscola, Rep. Richard Grucela, Janet Miller and members of the Friends of the Library, to name a few. The officials and guests presented checks and encouragement for our fundraising efforts.

The Bangor Public Library roof must be replaced to keep the Library's books and ceilings dry. The funds to pay for the roof are being raised throughout the community. **Your help is still needed.** The roof work is scheduled to begin in July. Have you seen the "umbrella sign" in the Library parking lot? Your donation will help ensure the completion of the roof!

The library runs on a fiscal year from July 1-June 30. So now, at the end of June, our fiscal year is ending. Circulation, attendance and number of new patrons is anticipated to be higher than last year. This year, we were pleased to replace the two Internet computers. We also have an updated Internet policy.

Now the Library has the Daily News index online. Lots of information requests have been filled. In August, the library's annual report to the State, will be completed.
