During March the library changed from one catalog system to another. There were some issues with the change over but now we hope to have many of those issues resolved. The new catalog system will allow a patron to go to their home computer—with internet access— and search the Bangor Library catalog. Now there are book covers pictured with some of the titles. You will need to go to the website—www.bangorlibrary.org and select the catalog. You will need to create a username and password that is unique to you for access to the renewal and hold section.
