### NEW WEBSITE AVAILABLE and other library news...

The library's new website will soon be up and running. Please be patient at first with the changes. If you experience any difficulty, please contact the library so we can find a solution. The information on the website will basically be the same as the current website but with a different look. The catalog will still be available from your home Internet connection along with the Daily News index. There will be a materials request form in case you want an item that Bangor Library does not have, fill out the information form and your request will be emailed to the library.

OneClickDigital will also be up and running shortly. The delay is from the company upgrading to the new platform. Once this program is in place, a library user can access a selection of audio books that can be downloaded to an ipod or an MP3 player. You must have a Bangor Public Library card to download audio books.

Young Authors contest winners Devon Pfeifer and Darien Drew Vrontisis were presented with their winning entries on Thursday September 22. Copies of their books, The good the bad and the desperate by Devon and Ian and the golden frog by Darien, are now available to check out from the library. Come check out the winning entries!
